

UCode - PYTHON IS THE LANGUAGE

Introduction to IoT Workshop

This course is to introduce the components of a car and teach our students to build a scooter. The course is divided into 3 parts. The first part is to introduce the components of a car and how to build a standard kart. During the second part of the course, we will ask our students to give us their ideas to personalise the scooter. At the end of the course, we shall add the development board and sensor to illustrate the concept of speed and how to check the speed with the students together. We shall also introduce the core coding and computing concepts in an age appropriate and fun way using animated videos developed by UCode. The concepts serve as the foundation for learning how to write good code. A great starting point for early age learners.

Introduction to Electric Vehicle Workshop with Python Coding using Blockly


This course is to provide our students with a preliminary understanding of the vehicle structure. We shall be teaching our students to use the building blocks, development board and in conjunction with python coding, to program the movement of the robot. Computational Thinking Skills are taught during the course. The challenges increase in difficulty and complexity requiring increasing levels of logic, problem decomposition and problem solving to answer the challenge. Each lesson includes exercises and quizzes to support learning retention. Lesson plans are also available for teachers and parents. This course was developed in partnership with Cornell University faculty.

UCode - PYTHON IS THE LANGUAGE

Introduction to Robotic Arm

In this course, we shall be teaching the student to use the development board, servo motors to make modifications to the electric vehicle to create a remote-controlled Robotic Arm.

Students also learn how to program the steering, drive and movement of the robotic arm. We shall be teaching students to use the Python language to code the instructions. Each lesson, a core programming concept is introduced using worksheets and quizzes. At the end of the course, the concept and theory of AI will be introduced to our students.




Python Game Development (Part 1)


You have an understanding of programming using Blocks and are familiar with the basic programming concepts. You are now ready to apply this knowledge using screen base programming in native Python. In Part 1 of this course, it will be an 8 weeks course of 1 hour each week that will see you building video games using Repl.it, an integrated development environment for Python. Each week we will introduce a core programming technique using worksheets and simple exercises. You will then apply these Python concepts to develop your fully featured video game. No templates. At the end of the course, the student will have designed and developed a game with sound and action as the deliverable, our student will apply the concept of computational thinking to design the game.




ILLUSTRATION - The art of visual interpretation & decoration of a concept or a text.

Project 1: Editorial Figuration

Whether you choose a piece on global deforestation or on Hong Kong's oldest tea shop, you will learn about popular editorial illustrators, experiment with drawing human figures, and embark on a journey to discover your own illustration style.

Project 2: Rendering Nature

Take cue from the 19th Century naturalist illustrator Maria Sibylla Merian and contemporary painter Jonas Wood. Looking at flora and fauna, from orchid to honeybee to baobab tree - capture nature in detail using watercolour, gouache, and diverse liner pen techniques. 

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TEXTILE - The art of conveying ideas and emotions by constructing practical outcomes out of fibre.

These workshops cover the fundamentals of Art & Design in relation to textile arts in the two terms proposed below. Participants will explore processes through swatches, build a mini portfolio, and produce experimental outcomes.



Project 1: Knit and Weave

Learn loom weaving with a variety of yarn and fabric to be built from a fine met I wire warp. Use a 'French knitting' (AKA spool knitting) device for further experiments in making a knitted tube. Your fin I works will display interesting impermanent volumes featuring a personal colour palette.

Project 2: Textural Image-Making

This mixed-media image-making workshop will be the platform for participants to employ a tactile format to render their favourite (living) thing or hobby (music, sports, etc). You will cover a diverse array of techniques such as collage, appliqué, linoleum and mono-printing using tactile materials.




